#### Introduction

Brač, Croatia has been chosen for the Autumn 2016, EuroGA fly-in.

Brač, a heavenly island located in the heart of the Adriatic Sea, is famous to two things: its white stone and Zlatni Rat which is its famous beach located near the town of Bol. The gorgeous Zlatni Rat beach can be found on almost all Croatian holiday brochures. The white limestone quarried on Brač was used for the construction of the White House in the USA and Diocletian Palace in Split.



There are two principal towns on Brač, Supetar and Bol, both well worth a visit. Supetar and Bol differ greatly from one another. Supetar is much larger and there is more to do, while Bol has a more exclusive appeal.

There are regular markets in Supetar where local produce and the famous limestone products can be purchased.

There are opportunities for boat trips around the island, water sports, wine and olive oil tasting, as well as plenty of opportunities for walking and hiking.

With average daily highs in September ranging from 18C to 26C, Brač is sure to be provide a great experience for the autumn EuroGA fly-in.

#### Activities on Brač

## **Boat Trips**

There are various boat trips that can be taken from both Supetar & Bol. A day trip around the whole island, which leaves from Supetar, and stops at Bol for lunch and at Pučišća, home of the famous white limestone, is highly recommended. Lunch on the boat is included.



## Markets

There are local markets along the shore in Supetar where you can buy a range of local handmade crafts and local foods. Pučišća has a market with a wide range of local stone products.

#### Beaches

The beach at Zlatni Rat, close to Bol is probably the most famous beach in Croatia, and is very picturesque. If you've seen a holiday brochure for Croatia, then you've probably seen the beach! There are various beaches around the island, along with beachside cafes and water sports. Generally the beaches along the south side of the island are the best of all.



### Walking and Hiking

There are plenty of opportunities for interesting walks and hikes on Brač.

Hike to the top of <u>Vidova Gora</u> for gorgeous views over Zlatni Rat.

Those looking for a long walk with a historical destination, may enjoy a hike up to Blaca Monastery.

Zmajeva Spilja (Dragon Cave) will provide an interesting visit for those brave enough to walk there.
