ECAC Recommendation INT.S11-1 (Dated 1982)

Recommendation:- "... that Member States accept home-built aircraft with a certificate of airworthiness or a "permit to fly" issued by another Member State, to fly in their country without any restrictions other than those stated in the certificate of airworthiness or "permit to fly".

Status



- Position not fully implemented and position not clear
- Agreed ECAC would survey members and identify status (Nov 2010) in progress
- Nations to progress bilaterals
- Work to expand agreement to national ex Factory (orphan) types



- Bilateral Agreements to include <u>ORPHAN</u> aircraft
 - UK France
 - UK Ireland
 - UK Channel Islands (and agreement to follow ECAC)
 - Ireland France initiated
 - UK Belgium Initiated
 - UK Netherlands (no response)
- ECAC progress & plan
 - ECAC Support being progressed. Concern at safety data on Annex II types. Get onto Coordinating Committee agenda & DGAC's approval to proceed..
 - Plan to finalise phase 1 (Establish position)
 - Develop phase 2 New ECAC Agreement to include Orphan types.

ECAC CC Approval required. Vital to progress bilaterals
