Aircraft Registration VH-BEL is subject to the following conditions:

12. The aircraft must be operated within the limitations expressed in the Experimental Exhibition Aircraft / PIPISTREL Panthera operations manual for the Panthera model.

13. Warning placards must be displayed in the cabin or cockpit at locations which ensure that the warning is in full view of any passenger in accordance with CAR 262AP.

14. This aircraft, VH-BEL SN: PX1520005 shall be maintained in accordance with the CASA Maintenance Schedule 5 with reference to the PIPISTREL d.o.o Panthera for the airframe and the requirements of the CASA AD/ENG 4 for the engine as amended from time to time for the power plant.

15. An appropriate Licensed Aircraft Maintenance Engineer(LAME) may certify for condition inspections in accordance with any conditions entered on this special certificate of airworthiness, and issue a Maintenance Release, pursuant to Instrument No CASA10/19 or later issue.

16. Certification for maintenance carried out on this aircraft shall be in accordance with the CASA system of certification of completion of maintenance, except as described in items 17 of this annex.

17. No person shall operate this aircraft unless, within the preceding 12 calendar months, it has had a Condition inspection performed in accordance with CASA Schedule 5 with reference to the PIPISTREL d.o.o Panthera maintenance schedule for the airframe and the requirements of the AD/ENG 4 as amended from time to time for the power plant plus any additional requirements in the inspection schedule and has been found to be in a condition for safe operation.

The entry will include the aircraft total time in service, the name, signature, and certificate type and number of the person performing the inspection.

19. In accordance with CAR {1988} 262AP (5), I hereby authorise the operation of this aircraft over built-up area of a city or town subject to the following conditions,

(a) Except for take-off and landings, or when following a prescribed procedure, or when otherwise authorised by CASA or an Authorised Person, Flight over any person or dwellings shall be at such a combination of height and speed as to permit the pilot to glide clear of all persons and dwellings, in the event of an engine failure.

20. Applications may be made to an Authorised Person or CASA for any revision to these operating limitations.
